Understanding Autism and Neurodivergence

This seminar will cover-

Introduction to autism - what this means, examples of autistic experience, brief summary of diagnostic criteria, raising awareness of what indicators to look out for.

Supportive seating is probably the most widely used piece of therapy equipment in a child's 24-hour postural management plan.

Thanks to advancements in therapy techniques, technical innovations and a user-centered design approach, there has been a notable shift in the equipment provided in recent years. There is now a growing recognition that the child's age, developmental stage, task, ability and environment
